Rules & Regulations

- Contestants may be a resident of the following counties **ONLY: Crittenden, Henderson, Union, & Webster**; and must be able to prove their residency by home telephone number in a published phone book or by a piece of mail with **parents'** name and address. **Contestants must be 8 years of age on June 30, 2021 and cannot be 13 on October 31 2021.** Miss Pre-Teen Union County is **required** to participate in the 2021 Miss Pre-Teen Kentucky County Fair pageant held in Louisville fall 2021, date TBD. If she is unable to do so, the 1st Runner-up will take her place for the remainder of the reign unless otherwise approved by the pageant directors. **A formal pageant gown will be required for State Competition, in October.**
- Contestants will participate in two phases of competition: Interview and Onstage Modeling (including an introduction).
- Interview attire will be as follows: solid colored top and solid colored bottoms (**NO prints on tops or bottoms**). **NO dresses allowed for interview.** If you have questions regarding this attire please do not hesitate to ask the directors. Shoes are at the discretion of the contestant. Judges will only be able to ask age appropriate questions and/or questions pertaining to the contestant's information sheet.
- Onstage modeling attire will be as follows: Sunday Best Dress (NOT formal). NO strapless dresses. **NO PAGEANT GOWNS ALLOWED.** If there is any beading or sequins on the dress it must be isolated to one area such as around the hem or neckline of the dress. Dress must be **at least 3 INCHES off the floor.** Make sure if your dress is a shorter length that is it **NOT TOO SHORT.** The contestants will be well above the eye level of the judges and that makes short dresses look even shorter.. **You will be disqualified if you wear a formal gown or attire that breaks the rules, so please ask us if you aren't sure!**
- Suggestions for hair and makeup: **Hair** – for interview and onstage judges like a natural look (not super fancy). **Makeup** –Interview: keep it to a minimum(such as powder, mascara and lipstick/gloss). Onstage: may wear foundation or powder, light eye shadow and blush, etc. You may wear jewelry, heels, or flats, but keep it age appropriate.
- Remember this is a **PRE-TEEN** pageant and the judges are going to be looking for someone who is age appropriate in hair, makeup and dress so don't over do it.
- The winner of the pageant will be required to meet with the directors for a practice session prior to the state pageant. We will practice interview and modeling skills, as well as consult on an appropriate wardrobe for the state pageant.
- The winner of the pageant will also be **REQUIRED TO BE AVAILABLE THE WEEK OF THE FAIR** for any and all appearances that she might need to make **at other fair events** (this includes daytime and evening events). She will be **REQUIRED** to wear her crown and sash at all events and be **dressed and ACT appropriately given the specific setting of the appearance.** The winner will also be **REQUIRED** to make appearances throughout the year for parades and other County-wide events (to be determined by the pageant directors). Please remember throughout the year, wherever you are, that you are representing Union County and do so appropriately!
